

MONSOON ALERT

The Pune-Bengaluru National Highway-4 in Kolhapur's Shirol area was closed for traffic movement following waterlogging on the route due to continuous rain in the region.

Traffic movement on the stretch was halted after flooding in Panchganga river in Kolhapur district following which Karnataka also stopped vehicular movement near Belagavi.

The best alternative route to avoid the National Highway-4 in Kolhapur's Shirol from Pune to Bengaluru is Pune to Solapur NH-09 (New NH-65)- Solapur to Vijayapura NH13 (New NH-52)- Vijayapura to Chitradurga NH-50 – Chitradurga to Bengaluru NH-04 (New NH- 48) which covers the distance from Pune to Bengaluru – appx. 860 Km Distance .

Sangli -Solaour update

In NHA section from 182/200 to 370/00 Km (197.8 km) only 182/200 to 185/000 (2.8 km) is under water all other is clear for traffic & traffic is moving smoothly.

Pune Satara highway damages under repair. PD and Managers remained full day on highway attending maintenance. Satara Kolhapur highway still closed, supplies being maintained. 15 Aviation fuel tankers carrying 20000 litre each from Pune to Kolhapur are passed with the help of poclain. PD is on the job to restore traffic as soon water recedes.
