NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 19th October, 2011

S.O. 2421(E).— Whereas, by notifications of the Government of India in the erstwhile Ministry of Surface Transport (Roads Wing) number SO 267 (E) dated the 30th March, 1998 and S.O. 78 (E), dated the 4th February, 1999 issued under section 11 of the National Highways Authority of India Act, 1988 (68 of 1988) (hereinafter referred to as said Act), the Central Government entrusted the stretches from Km Km 27.80 - Km 61.00 (Jagatpur - Chandikhole section) and Km 233.00 - Km 418.00 (Andhra Pradesh/ Orissa Border to Bhubaneswar section), Km 0.00 - Km 27.80 and Km 61.00 - Km 200.00 (Bhubaneswar - Balasore section) of National Highway No 5 in the State of Orissa to the National Highways Authority of India (hereinafter referred to as the Authority);

And whereas, pursuant to the provisions of section 14 of the said Act, the Authority has entered into an agreement with M/s Shree Jagannath Expressways Private Limited, having its registered office at Simplex House, 27 Shakespeare Sarani, Kolkatta - 700017 (hereinafter referred to as the Concessionaire) for the development, operation and maintenance of the existing four lane section from Km 413.000 - Km 418.000 and Km 0.000 - Km 62.000 (Bhubaneswar - Jagatpur - Chandikhole section) of the National Highway No. 5 in the State of Orissa (hereinafter referred to as the said section) to six lane divided carriageway on Design, Build, Finance, Operate and Transfer (DBFOT) basis;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8A of the National Highways Act, 1956 read with the National Highways Fee (Determination of Rates and Collection) Rules, 2008, and in supersession of the notifications of the Government of India in the erstwhile Ministry of Shipping, Road Transport and Highways (Department of Road Transport and Highways) number SO 1527 (E) dated the 18th September, 2006, SO 1774 (E) dated the 16th October, 2006 and SO 1392 (E) dated the 2nd June, 2008 except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession , the Central Government hereby notifies that there shall be levied and collected fees on type of mechanical vehicles specified in the following Tables, for the use of said section at the base rate specified thereof, and authorizes the said Concessionaire to collect and retain the fee subject to and in accordance with the said rules and the provisions of the said concession agreement on and from the date of commercial operation or publication of this notification in the Official Gazette, whichever is later, till the termination date, namely:--

Notes:-

1. For the purpose of this notification,-
 - (i) "actual fee" means the fees actually charged from the road users of the said section on the basis of-
 - (a) length of the project highway assigned to each fee plaza;
 - (b) base fee rates provided in the above Table duly indexed, and shall be rounded off to nearest Five rupee;
 - (ii) "date of commercial operation" means the date on which commercial operation of the said section begins after satisfying all Conditions Precedent in accordance with the said agreement;
 - (iii) "termination date" means the date on which the agreement entered into between the Authority and the Concessionaire expires pursuant to the provisions of the said agreement or is terminated by termination notice;
 - (iv) words and expressions used in this notification and not defined but defined in the agreement entered into between the Authority and the Concessionaire in respect of the said section shall have the same meaning as assigned to them respectively in the said agreement.

2. The fee shall be collected at the following location of toll plaza for the distance specified against the toll plaza:

A. During construction period.

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3. Exemption from payment of fee, rates of fee for overloaded vehicles, discounts in rates etc shall be in accordance with the National Highways Fee (Determination of Rates and Collection) Rules, 2008.
4. For multiple journey on the highway section, passes shall be issued at the following rates, namely:

Amount Payable	Maximum number of one way journeys allowed	Period of validity
One and half times of the fee for one way journey	Two	Twenty four hours from the time of payment
Two-third of amount of the fee payable for fifty or more single journeys	Fifty or more	One month from date of payment

5. The rate of monthly pass for local personal traffic is Rs. 150.00 (One Hundred fifty Rupees) for the year 2007-08 which is subject to revision every year as per the provisions of the said rules.
6. The revision of fee shall not be effected until a period of six months has elapsed from the date immediately preceding determination of Fee hereunder.

With reference to the cited reference, it is to be intimated that the Competent Authority has approved the following revised schedule of user fee upto 31.03.2013 for Chandikhole Jagatpur Bhubaneshwar section of NH-5:
